Palm Sunday: The Sunday of the Passion, March 28 at 9:00 am

Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week. Our Palm Sunday service begins by recalling Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem and ends with a somber reading of the Passion according to Mark.

Maundy Thursday, April 1 at 7:00 pm

The word "maundy" comes from the Latin "*mandatum*" meaning "commandment." We remember the Last Supper at which Jesus gave his disciples a new commandment to "love one another."

Good Friday, April 2 at 7:00 pm

On Good Friday we commemorate the crucifixion of Jesus. Traditionally, it is a day of fasting. This service includes the reading of the Passion according to John and a series of solemn collects.

Great Vigil of Easter, April 3 at 7:30 pm

Please join Bishop Johnson and Dean Adams-Shepherd for the Great Vigil of Easter which begins in darkness and a new fire lit, from which the Paschal candle will be lighted. The service has four parts: The Service of the Light, The Service of Lessons (stories of our salvation history), Christian Initiation (Holy Baptism) or the Renewal of Baptismal Vows, and the Eucharist. This is the first celebration of Easter!
