



If You Are Missing Parish Emails – Here’s What to Do

If you are missing weekly Friday parish emails, you will need to add the parish email blast address as a contact in your email account. This must be done on your personal mail service’s internet **server**. So it is recommended that you use a desktop or laptop to add the parish contact. [Adding the contact in your smartphone or tablet contact list may not work.](#)

Once parish emails are released, our service has absolutely no control over your incoming mail server settings, or any new filter restrictions your personal mail service has executed. We have found evidence that recent parish emails that included clicking links (i.e. Zoom links) have been going to your spam (trash). You are particularly at risk for spam and missing emails if you use one of the following email services:

yahoo.com
sbcglobal.net
att.net
aol.com

If you are using any of these services, it is highly recommended that you make the following simple fix to prevent missing future weekly emails:
